Description of Privacy Notice: This Privacy Notice explains how Caerphilly County Borough

Council will use the personal information obtained via the National Standards Cycle Training consent form to provide cycle training to children whose parent/guardian have given

consent for them to be part of the project.

How we will use your information

Source and type of information being processed

Source and type of information being processed

Caerphilly County Borough Council provide a pro forma letter/consent form for those schools selected to be part of the initiative to send to parents to invite them to consent to their child taking part in the National Cycle Training project. Completed forms will contain the name of the participant and the signature of their parent/guardian and will be shared with the training provider to enable them to provide the training.

When the training has been completed, the training provider submits an evaluation report to the Council which includes the name of the participant, if they attended the training and the outcome i.e. pass, fail, reason for fail.

Purpose and legal basis for using your information

Purpose of processing

We will use the information you provide on the National Cycle Training consent form to provide cycle training designed to give children the skills they need to negotiate a safe cycle journey. This Welsh Government funded project is co-ordinated by the Road Safety service and is delivered by an approved external cycling trainer and requires each participating child's name to enable the project to run. These details will be used to create administer the project and produce training/evaluation records. Parents/guardians are required to give their consent to enable their child to participate in the training by signing the form and consequently their signature is held.

Legal basis for processing

In order for the processing of personal data to be lawful under the General Data Protection Regulations 2016, a valid condition from Article 6 of the Regulations must be identified which is outlined below:

Article 6(1)(f) – processing is necessary for the purpose of the legitimate interests pursued by the controller or by a third party, except where such interests are overridden by the interests or fundamental rights or freedoms of the data subject which require protection of personal data, in particular where the data subject is a child.

The 1988 Road Traffic Act, Section 39, puts a "statutory duty" on the local authority to undertake studies into road traffic collisions, and to take steps both to reduce and prevent them.

The right to withdraw consent

You have the right to withdraw your consent to your child being part of this project and if you would like to do this, please contact the Service Area whose details are contained on the top of this document. However, we will still process your information for the purpose of evidencing that your child was allocated a place but was subsequently withdrawn from the project by you.
