Gwahardd cerbydau rhag mynd ar hyd St Martins Road rhwng y cyffyrdd â Lôn-y-Llyn a B4263 Mountain Road am bellter o tua 760 metr; AC

Atal dros dro y cyfyngiad terfyn pwysau ar hyd A469 Watford Road rhwng cylchfan Penrhos a'r gyffordd â B4263 Mountain Road, a B4263 Mountain Road rhwng y cyffyrdd â St Martins Road ac A469 Watford Road, Caerffili.

Disgwyli'r Gorchymyn arfaethedig gychwyn ar 2 Ionawr 2024 am gyfnod nid yn fwy na deunaw mis neu nes bod y gwaith wedi ei gwblhau, p'un bynnag sydd gynharaf. Disgwyli'r gwaith gael ei gwblhau erbyn 31 Mawrth 2024.

Bydd mynediad ar gael i'r gwasanaethau brys, preswylwyr a cherddwyr, lle bo modd. Bydd mynediad ar gael i Ysgol Gyfun Martin Sant.

Bydd llwybr arall ar gael ar hyd Lôn-y-Llyn, A469 Watford Road, B4263 Mountain Road.

Temporary Prohibition of Driving and Temporary Suspension of Weight Limit Restriction Order 2023

NOTICE is hereby given that Caerphilly County Borough Council in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) intends in not less than seven days from the date of this Notice to make an Order, the effect of which will be to :-

Prohibit vehicles from proceeding along St Martins Road between its junctions with Lon Y Llyn and B4263 Mountain Road for a distance of approx.. 760 metres; AND

Temporarily suspend the weight limit restriction along A469 Watford Road between Penrhos Roundabout and its junction with B4263 Mountain Road. B4263 Mountain Road between its junction with St Martins Road and A469 Watford Road, Caerphilly.

The proposed Order is expected to commence on 2 January 2024 for a period not exceeding eighteen months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated the works will be completed by 31 March 2024.

Access for emergency services, residents and pedestrians will be maintained where possible. Access to St Martins School will be maintained.

Alternative routes are via Lon Y Llyn, A469 Watford Road, B4263 Mountain Road.

The reason for making the Order is to allow for gas mains replacement.

The order is required by Wales & West Utilities.
