TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING ORDER 2024

NOTICE is hereby given that Caerphilly County Borough Council in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) intends in not less than seven days from the date of this Notice to make an Order, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from proceeding along

Station Road, Bargoed from its junction with Bargoed Station car park to A469 Factory Road, for a distance of 320 metres in a northerly direction

The proposed Order is expected to commence on 8 June 2024 for a period not exceeding eighteen months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated the works will be complete by 14 June 2024.

From 08:00 until 18:00 on Saturday 8 June 2024

From 08:00 until 18:00 on Sunday 9 June 2024

From 21:00 on Monday 10 until 05:30 Tuesday 11 June 2024

From 21:00 on Tuesday 11 until 05:30 Wednesday 12 June 2024

From 21:00 on Wednesday 12 until 05:30 Thursday 13 June 2024

Access for emergency services, residents and pedestrians will be maintained.

Alternative routes are via Bridge Street, Bedwellty Road, Commercial Street, Commercial Street link Road, Angel Way

Alternative routes for HGV follow Angel Way, Commercial Street Link Road, Commercial Street, Cwmsyflog Road, White Rose Way, James Street, High Street, Graig Rhydney, High Street, Southend Terrace, Waterloo Terrace, Merchant Street, Pontlottyn Link Road, Carno Street and return via Pontlottyn Link Road, Merchant Street, Waterloo Terrace, Southend Terrace, High Street, Graig Rhydney, Pleasant View, unnamed road (Gwaelodybrithdir Cemetery to Coedcae), Factory Road.

The reason for making the Order is to allow for overhead tree maintenance works.
